Flat Tyres

We all know how annoying a flat tyre can be, and it usually happens at the most inconvenient time – no one knows what causes them, it could be an object on the road that has punctured your tyre.

BUT – as well as being an inconvenience, and costing you valuable time and money. It could cause a serious accident if your tyre blows out at a high speed, indeed it could cost you your life or that of someone else.

There are many different things that you can and should do to ensure that your tyres are operating at their optimum level and we cover these on the next few slides.

Maintain Correct Tyre Pressures

It is always advisable to have your tyres checked on a weekly or monthly basis – you can either do this by yourself or visit your local Car Workshop or Tyre Fitment Centre who will be happy to help.

Your manufacturers handbook supplied with your car explains what the correct tyre pressures for your particular vehicle should be, if however you cannot find this – some manufacturers will place the recommended tyre pressures on a sticker either on the driver door pillar or in the glove box in the car.

Always maintain your tyres at the correct pressures as advised.



Why is this so important?

The only thing between you and the road – are your tyres!

Just think? – we all spend so much time, cleaning, polishing, adding on ‘extra accessories’ to our cars and most of us – forget one thing – **OUR TYRES!**



In a recent independent tests carried out in the UK it was found that as well as reducing the likelihood of being involved in an accident, the correct tyre pressures can provide a longer tyre life as well as reduced fuel bills.

What else can I do?

Ensure all your tyres are properly inflated and checked at least once a month and before any long journeys – don't forget the spare tyre

Check the condition of your tyres by looking for any lumps, bulges or cracks and remove any objects embedded in the tread

When checking the tread, pressures and condition, don't forget the spare tyre

Always check your tyre pressures when the tyres are cold – this is the only way to get an accurate reading

Always inflate the tyres ONLY to the manufacturers recommended pressures

How does TYRESAFE work?

- It is simply installed via the tyre pressure valve – where you normally fill your tyre with air
 - As your tyre rotates – the centrifugal force disperses the gel around the inner tyre tread area – forming a unique bond with your tyres inner surface
 - As soon as an object ‘punctures’ the tyre tread area, the gel is drawn by the residing air and in a millisecond – seals the puncture wound permanently
 - The gel reacts so effectively that virtually no air loss happens – it will seal hundreds of punctures!
 - It is a PERMANENT SEAL



How safe is your product?



It has been manufactured in the United Kingdom since 1992 and our factory is ISO 9002 accredited

It does not affect your tyre manufacturers warranty – in fact, it enhances the lifespan of your tyre !

When you do decide to change your tyres, it simply rinses out with water as the product is biodegradable

It is so effective at sealing puncture wounds that we guarantee it will seal a wound up to 6mm in diameter on a car and up to 10mm on slow earth moving equipment
